



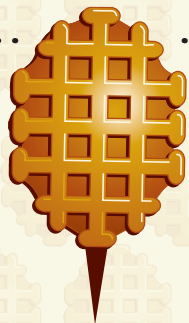
STORING AND RE-HEATING SUGAR WAFFLES

Waffle Cabin® Sugar waffles are all natural without any preservatives as sugar is a natural preservative. This will keep the sugar waffles fresh enough so you do not have to freeze them if consumed within 3-5 days of receiving the waffles.

The best place to store the waffles for a few days is in a cool and dry place (but not in the fridge); they can be stored at room temperature. To preserve the freshness as much as possible we recommend freezing the waffles upon receipt.

If storing in a freezer...

Freezers dry out anything you put in it and this includes baked goods. We suggest consuming the waffles within 8 weeks from receipt. Store waffles in their original packaging (cellophane bag) and if possible in a plastic bag. Obviously, a reheated waffle is not the same as a fresh waffle. We do our very best however to create the very best quality we can and in case you are not satisfied with your purchase, please let us know. Waffles can be enjoyed both hot and cold. On hot days, try the waffle cold as a snack/cookie.

A. If you have a toaster oven AND microwave:

- Take frozen waffle out of cellophane bag.
- Put in microwave for 20 seconds.
- Put waffle in toaster oven for 30-45 seconds depending on the desired "crunchiness".
- Best is to let cool (preferably on cooling rack) for about 10-20 seconds.

B. If you have only a toaster oven:

- Put frozen waffle in toaster oven for 1 minute (on toast) or about 3 minutes on 350°.
- Best to let cool (preferably on cooling rack) for about 10-20 seconds.

C. If you have only a microwave oven:

- Put frozen waffle in microwave for about 40-45 seconds.
- Best is to let cool (preferably on cooling rack) for about 10-20 seconds.

Adjust heating time by half if your waffle is not frozen.



Serve waffle in wax paper (included), and wrap a napkin around wax paper, or make it fancy with strawberries, whipped cream, chocolate... the options are not limited....start munching!
